

Air Plant/Tillandsia Care Instructions

These unusual looking plants come from the family of Bromeliads. The Bromeliad family includes a wide range of plants such as the pineapple and Spanish Moss. Tillandsia is epiphytic, which means that it is able to grow without soil. They are tremendously adaptable, tolerating a wide range of conditions.

LIGHT: Plenty of strong light. Okay to put outside in warm months. When placing outdoors, put in shaded area. Some direct sun is okay. Too much direct sun will burn up this plant.

WATER: Water twice a week, either by misting or by dunking in water. Water more often with intense light or heat.

TEMPERATURE: Will grow in any temp 40-90 degrees.

FERTILIZER: Soak or spray mist once a month with a mild/light fertilized water.
