

Asiatic Lily Care Instructions

Light: Medium to high light conditions are best. Place near a sunny window but protect from direct sunlight. Plant outside in full sun.

Water: Moderately moist soil is preferred. However, allow soil to feel dry before watering thoroughly.

Temperature: Average temps 65-70 degrees. Avoid excessive hot or cold areas.

Key Tip for Success:

If desired, remove yellow anthers as buds open to avoid staining petals with pollen.

To enjoy in your garden, cut off stems and leaves when they are no longer green. Plant bulbs outdoors 4-6" deep with the pointed tip up. Add bone meal to the soil at the time of planting and fertilize once a year in the spring with a slow-release fertilizer. In the fall, use 2-3" of mulch to protect against winter. Pull away mulch as soon as sprouts begin.

Blooms June - July and grows 2-3' tall outdoors
