

Calla Care Instructions

Uprturned trumpet shaped flowers: pink, white, yellow and purple with solid green or spotted arrow shaped leaves. Calla grow from underground rhizomes & bloom in early spring.

Light: Full sun to bright or direct light

Water: Let plant get slightly dry between watering. Don't let it sit in water. If kept too wet, it will rot.

Temperature: COOL temperatures. Blooms will last much longer if kept in a cool area of the home.

Fertilizer: Lightly while actively growing.

Indoors: Likes good air circulation

Outdoors:

- Good soil preparation is important with humus.
- Bone meal or super phosphate mixed into the soil before planting usually produces larger flowers & better growth.
- The rooted rhizomes are to be planted outside after the danger of frost and should come back inside before winter. Store in slightly damp sand or peat moss. In spring, plant in good rich soil either outside or in a pot for indoors.
