

Cordyline Care Instructions

This plant looks like a young palm tree. The foliage is deep green to maroon bordered in pink. The leaves can grow to be 15" long while the plant can average 2 feet in height.

Light: Most varieties should be grown in full sunlight. However, some varieties must not be subjected to direct sunlight or their leaves will be scorched. For those varieties, they need bright filtered light.

Water: During active growth period, water plentifully as often as necessary to keep the potting mixture thoroughly moist, but never allow the plants to stand in water. During the resting period, water only enough to keep the potting mix from drying out.

Temperature: Average. Some varieties can take temps as low as 50 degrees.

Fertilizer: Feed every 2 weeks during the growing season.
