

Indoor Bulb Plant Care Instructions

LIGHT: Medium-Bright light location is best. Place near a sunny window, but protected from direct sun.

WATER: Moderately moist soil is best, NEVER let the plants dry out

FERTILIZER: Not necessary

TEMPERATURE: Best 60 to 64 degrees at night and 65 to 70 degrees during the day. Most temperatures found in the home are acceptable. Cooler locations will greatly improve the lasting quality. Blossoms will last longer if the plant is kept cool. When flowers are not needed for display, move the pot to a cooler location to extend its life. Anywhere above 35 degrees preferably with light. Avoid excessively hot or freezing locations.

It's good to keep plants tied up with stakes. With their fast indoor growth, they should be tied up so that they do not fall over. As the plant grows, raise the string or the ring to keep giving it support.
